Adding Custom CSS Files

Magento comes with a number of pre-written CSS files, not all of which are included in the XHTML file output by the PHP code. While it is possible to add CSS styles to the files that are included, you may want to include your own custom CSS file in the XHTML output. One of the files not included is a blank CSS file named “custom.css”. You can edit this file with your own CSS style definitions and then include it in the XHTML output by editing the “page.xml” file in the “layout” subdirectory of your default theme directory.

Look for the following code in that file:

```
<action method="addCss"><stylesheet>css/reset.css</stylesheet></action>  
<action method="addCss"><stylesheet>css/boxes.css</stylesheet></action>  
<action method="addCss"><stylesheet>css/clears.css</stylesheet></action>  
<action method="addCss"><stylesheet>css/menu.css</stylesheet></action>
```

Add the following line immediately following the above code:

```
<action method="addCss"><stylesheet>css/custom.css</stylesheet></action>
```
